

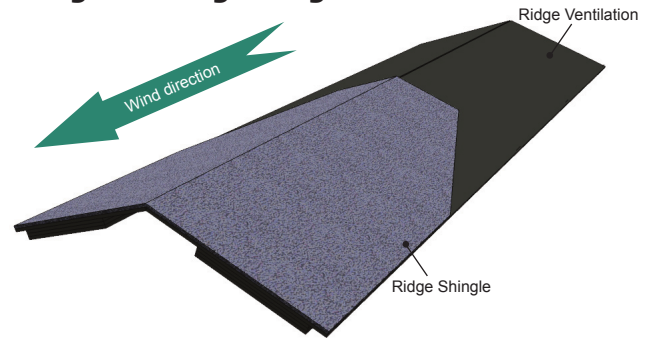
### 1.51 - Ridge & Hip Shingle Installation.

A special ridge shingle is supplied and the laminate shingle should not be used for hips and ridges.

Hips are laid from gutter line upwards with 142mm exposure.

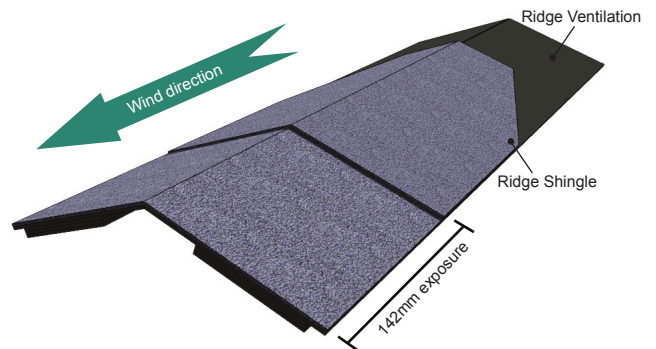
Ridges are to be laid away from the prevailing winds. Shingles are to be cut and sealed to form a water tight joint at the hip/ridge junction.

**Fig 1.52 - Ridge Shingle.**



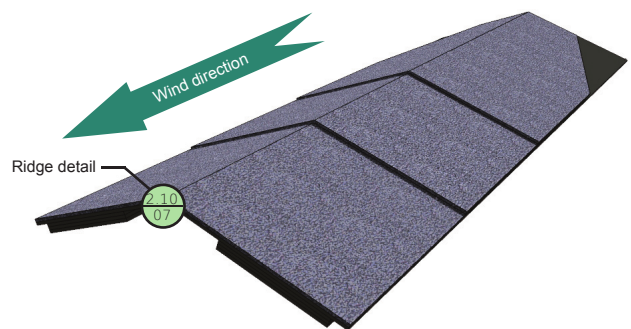
First layer of ridge shingle must be located away from the direction of prevailing wind.

**Fig 1.53 - Over-lapped Ridge Shingle.**



Second ridge shingle is to over-lap the previous shingle with 142mm exposure.

**Fig 1.54 - Consequently...**



Finished results should look similar to above illustration (refer to Technical Drawings for more detailed information).
